Pitch Count – Catcher Rules

- **New for 2010:** A player who catches in one game may not pitch in another game on that same day. Similarly, a pitcher in the first game may not catch in any other game on that day.

Pitch Count

SASKATOON PEE WEE BASEBALL PITCH COUNT RULES - 2010

NOTE: A rest day commences at 12:01 am following the day the pitcher was used i.e. the number of nights of sleep a player is required to have before pitching again is always one more than the number of days of rest.

The following rules are also in effect:

1. Pitchers may **not** throw 3 consecutive days in a row.
2. Pitchers may have 2 appearances on the same calendar day provided no more than 30 pitches are thrown in the first appearance and the total pitch count for the day does not exceed the maximum pitch limit. (An appearance is defined as one pitch or more thrown in a game.)
3. Pitchers will be permitted to finish the batter if his or her **maximum** pitch limit has been reached for that day.
4. Intentional walks will be included in pitch count totals.

31 - 45	1 day rest
46 - 60	2 days rest
61 - 75	3 days rest
76 - 90	4 days rest
<i>Total allowed pitches in a day</i>	90

PEE WEE	
Number of Pitches	Rest Period
1 - 30	No rest required
31 - 45	1 day rest
46 - 60	2 days rest
61 - 75	3 days rest
76 - 85	4 days rest
<i>Total allowed pitches in a day</i>	85

MIDGET	
Number of Pitches	Rest Period
1 - 30	No rest required
31 - 45	1 day rest
46 - 60	2 days rest
61 - 75	3 days rest
76 - 100	4 days rest
<i>Total allowed pitches in a day</i>	100
