Registration in age categories from 5 to 18 is open to all boys and girls living in the Blue Jay's Zone (north of College Drive and east of Circle Drive). Out of town boundaries for the Blue Jays zone include those players east of the River and north of Highway #5. **If you do not reside in Saskatoon you must complete and bring to registration an 'Out of Zone Transfer' form that can be found on the Saskatoon Baseball website at www.baseballsaskatoon.com under the 'Zone Map' section.**

Payment for online registration:

- Payment can be made online via **Paypal** or by cheque (made payable to Saskatoon Blue Jays Baseball) mailed to **Kelly Coverett, 207 Pobran Lane, Saskatoon, S7S 1L4.**

Included in this package is a Registration Form that you should complete and bring to **the on-site registration if you choose not to register online.**

- Complete all relevant details on the form in advance. **Email address is critical, as the majority of communication will be done via email.**
- One cheque that covers both the Blue Jay Zone registration fees **PLUS** the Saskatoon Baseball Capital Improvement Fund (\$5 for Rookie and Jr Mosquito, \$10 per player for Mosquito age groups and older).
- Please make cheque payable to Saskatoon Blue Jays Baseball. Official tax receipts will be issued at registration.
- For personal hygiene benefits, **all players in all age groups** will be responsible for providing their own batting helmet (approximately \$15.00).
- **UNIFORMS:** uniform sizing **WILL NOT** be done at time of registration. Uniforms will be sized and distributed at a different date just prior to the start of the season. **Thus you do not need to bring your child with you to registration.**
- The Zone will continue to provide ball pants for Rookie, Jr. Mosquito and Mosquito age groups. All older players (Pee Wee, Bantam and Midget) will be required to supply their own pants (grey)
- **New this year, as an incentive to use your ball hat from last year, the zone will reduce your registration fee by \$10.**
- Parents and others interested in coaching must complete a **Coaching Application Form.** These will be available at Registration or may be downloaded from our website: www.saskatoonbluejays.com.

As in the previous years, all players wanting to join the AAA teams must be able to commit to the following: City Championships, Provincial Qualifiers, Provincial Championships and Westerns/Nationals if the team qualifies. The regular season will begin in late April/early May and run through June for the Rookie, Jr. Mosquito and Mosquito divisions and possibly into July for Pee-Wee and older divisions. Teams entering Provincials (this doesn't apply to Rookies or Jr. Mosquito) will play in July.

Baseball can't run without the help of volunteers. We encourage parents to fill out on the Registration Form what type of volunteer service they can provide.
