- Fencers not present at close of registration for their event will be withdrawn or subject to a \$50.00 penalty, at the discretion of the Directoire Technique

- All times are Central Standard and are subject to change depending on the number of entries
- Events for which there are fewer than 6 entries received by the entry deadline will be cancelled or run as combined gender.

ENTRY FEES:

- Administration Fee: \$20 (non-refundable)
- Event Fees: Cadet Events: \$20 | Junior Events: \$30 | Senior Events: \$40
- The above fees apply if entry and payment are received by 11:59 PM CST, Wednesday, April 23. ***For entries received after Wednesday, April 23, all fees are doubled.***

ENTRY REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

- Voice, fax, email and surface mail entries will *not* be accepted
- Entries will *only* be accepted online at <http://2008westerns.saskfencing.com/>
- Fencers may enter more than one event on each day, however they will be required to withdraw from an event if their entry will impede the progress of the competition. Fencers must remain in the event in progress.
- Athletes eligible for cadet events are those who were under seventeen years of age as of January 1, 2008, i.e. born in 1991 or since.
- Athletes eligible for junior events are those who were under twenty years of age as of January 1, 2008, i.e. born in 1988 or since.
- Athletes eligible for Master Mixed Foil are those who were born in 1978 or before. (*This is an unofficial event and will not be sanctioned by the CFF. Results will not be submitted for inclusion in the Domestic Rankings.*)
- Acceptance of entry is contingent upon acceptance of waiver by athlete; and parent or guardian in the case of an athlete who is under eighteen years of age. Acceptance of waiver signifies that the person has read, understood, and agrees to the conditions stipulated in the waiver and in Article 16 of the FIE Regulations of Competition.

EQUIPMENT CONTROL:

- Mask check by armorer prior to start of each event. Weapons and other equipment to be checked by referees on piste.

FORMAT:

- 1st round of pools of 6 and/or 7; all fencers promoted to a direct elimination tableau (no repechage)

RULES:

- The latest FIE rules will apply except regarding Kevlar clothing and maraging blades. All competitors are required to wear proper fencing clothing. No sweatpants or windpants will be allowed.

WAIVER FOR 2008 WESTERNS

Waiver of Liability:

I understand that by accepting the waiver on the online entry form I am waiving my rights to claim damages against the people described below and that I participate in fencing tournaments at my own risk.

In consideration of permission to participate in fencing tournaments in Canada I forever release the Canadian Fencing Federation, the Saskatchewan Fencing Association, the host clubs, the tournament organizers, all their employees and volunteers, and any individuals associated with the tournament, including the referees and the Directoire Technique, from any claims and demands whatsoever which I now have or might have, or which may be exerted against any or all of them for any injury or loss to my person or property, regardless of fault, arising in any way out of my participation in any fencing tournament.

Without limiting the above, I also understand that the Canadian Fencing Federation Rules and Regulations require me to wear complete regulation fencing clothing (mask, protective jacket and breeches, plastron, glove with gauntlet) at all stages of any tournament. If I do not follow the Rules and Regulations, I understand that I do so at my own risk.

I also understand that I am participating in such tournaments at my own risk and I accept full responsibility for my own safety.
