- 5) Shoes specifically for gymnasium use only are required.
- 6) Shoes and clothing for dry-land training.

Fencing tool kit: (Also for future use by fencer. Most items can be purchased for reasonable cost at Canadian Tire or similar store.)

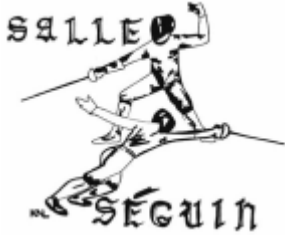
- 1) Set of jeweller's screwdrivers
- 2) 6 mm Allen key
- 3) Small pliers
- 4) Small vice grips
- 5) Utility knife with retractable blade
- 6) 1 tube of Super glue, Le Pages wood glue or Le Pages household cement
- 7) 3 small clear medicine bottles or 35 mm film containers
- 8) 1 piece of emery cloth
- 9) 1 slot head, medium width, short screw driver
- 10) Small plastic box or cloth bag to contain tools
- 11) Weapon tester/multi meter would be nice if possible (optional)

Note: This investment will pay for itself at least 1000%! It is required for personal equipment repair and upkeep. Classes on equipment repair will be held at the camp.
