**DATES:** March 27 & 28

**LOCATION:** *Perdue Recreation Complex*

Sanctioned by the Canadian Fencing Federation through the Saskatchewan Branch. **All Canadian competitors must be 2009-10 licencees of the CFF.** All Saskatchewan competitors must be current SFA Regular members except Under 13 and Master event participants may hold either a current SFA Regular or Limited Membership. Age Categories: Under 13: born 1997 or since; Cadet: born 1993 or since; Junior: born 1990 or since; SK Master: born 1980 or before.

**FEE:** \$18 registration fee + \$33 per event (all events, all age categories) or  
**\$12 registration fee + \$22 per event for payment received by discount deadline.**

Fencers may enter more than one event on each day; however they will be required to withdraw from an event if their entry will impede the progress of the competition. Fencers must remain in the event in progress.

**LATE CHECK-IN: \$10 PENALTY (if allowed to fence by Directoire)**

### **DISCOUNT DEADLINE:**

**ENTRY AND FEE MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE BY: 10:00 pm (CST), Thu., Mar. 25th.**

**RULES:** The latest FIE rules will apply except regarding FIE clothing, FIE blades, and foil bibs. **ALL COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROPER FENCING CLOTHING. NO SWEATPANTS OR WINDPANTS WILL BE ALLOWED.**

**ENTRY FORM:** All entries must be submitted using the online form available at [www.saskfencing.com](http://www.saskfencing.com)

**OPEN MIXED DUEL:** This one-hit Épée event will be in progress all day on Sunday, March 28th – matches begin at 9:00 a.m. but late entries will be accepted until 2:00 p.m. Each match has a three minute time limit. Double hits are recorded as a double loss. A complete round robin will be held to seed for the Direct Elimination Tableau. Double losses in the D.E. will be settled by a coin toss. There will only be a first prize: The Court Sword Épée. **Entry fee is \$10 for each fencer for this event. Make cheque payable to AGFA. Entries will only be accepted at the competition. (No advance registration required.)**

**DOUBLE SABRE:** Returns this year! Will be held on Sunday, March 28th. Time and fee to be determined. Enter at the competition.
