

NCCP CERTIFICATION STANDARDS FOR CAWA WRESTLING PROGRAMS

SECTION 16.2

NCCP Certification Standards for Wrestling

16.2.1 National Training Centres:

This policy was developed for all Primary, Secondary, Development & Club National Training Centres as listed under the CAWA Coaching Endowment Program.

- ▶ Certified Level IV (or CBET equivalent) within four years of initial employment by training centre.
- ▶ Certified Level III (or CBET equivalent) to receive funding from the CAWA as a N.T.C.
- ▶ Failure to meet the requirements would result in suspension of funds until the situation is rectified.

16.2.2 National Team Program:

This policy was developed for defining the coaching support certification levels for all coaches that participate in National Team programming for the CAWA.

Olympic Team	COC Requirements	
World Championships (Senior, Junior)	Head Coach	Level IV
	Assistant Coach (or CBET equivalent)	Level III
National Team Activities	Head Coach	Level IV
	Assistant Coach (or CBET equivalent)	Level III

16.2.3 National Championships:

Coaches must have the following NCCP certification requirements in order to coach in the corner at CAWA National Championships.

Senior National Championships	Certified Level III (or CBET equivalent)
Junior National Championships	Certified Level II (or CBET equivalent)
Cadet/Juvenile National Championships	Certified Level I (or CBET equivalent)
Bantam Festivals (A recommendation only)	Technical Level I (or CBET equivalent)

Notes: A procedure is being developed that will require coaches to provide proof of their coaching certification status at the CAWA registration process at all national championships. Below are some initial concepts for the development of such a procedure.

- ▶ Coaches will be required to show their NCCP passports in order to verify coaching status at the time of registration. The CAWA will have a list of coaches available from a master check list.
- ▶ Coaches receive an accreditation coaching pass for national events that would allow access to the corner. In cases where an athlete's coach is not able to attend to his corner, any properly attired registered athlete can sit in the wrestler's corner and offer encouragement, but cannot approach the officials.
- ▶ The registration process will be on an annual basis via the national office or a future wrestling coaches' association.

Other Sanctioned Events - will depend on the event.

For example;

Canada Games	Canada Games Requirements
Canada Cup	Certified Level III (or CBET equivalent)
Arctic Games	As per Technical Package
Aboriginal Games	As per Technical Package
CAWA Olympic Trials	Certified Level III (or CBET equivalent)

The CAWA will negotiate certification requirements for all events that require CAWA sanction or approval for their operation. This may include events that use the services of the CAWOA or the CAWA office staff.
