

Notice: 2010 Midget AAA Baseball Tryout (Please pass this on to interested people)

Saskatoon Midget Baseball League is conducting a Fall 2009 tryout for AAA baseball for the 2010 season. We are having 3 teams which will be drafting ~15-20 players each.

Players from Zone 6 (Saskatoon and surrounding area) are allowed to attend. While out-of-zone transfers are allowed, drafted players must obtain releases from their respective zone governors.

The tryout will be on Saturday and Sunday, Sept 12-13, 2009 at Lealos Field (check Baseball Saskatoon website for directions) from 12 pm to 4 pm, with sign-in at 11:30 am. Please be on time.

If you are interested in attending please email Pat Moser at royals.no9@gmail.com before Sept 6, 2009.

You are advised to attend if you are interested in playing AAA ball for the upcoming year but if you are unable to attend and want to be eligible for the draft you should respond to the address above also.

Only players on the draft list will be eligible for the draft. All interested players must register.

There is the possibility of a spring tryout if team rosters are not filled but this has not been finalized. If you want to play AAA next year you should get on the draft list for the fall tryout. When responding, please give the following information:

- last year's team;
- age, height and weight;
- preferred position(s);
- mailing address and phone number and email address.

Other AAA information:

3 teams in Saskatoon, city-wide and out-of-zone draft every year with teams allowed to protect some players.

There is a good chance the Saskatoon Midget AAA teams will be joining the Saskatchewan Midget Baseball League (SMBL) for the 2010 season. This will mean interlocking games (home and away) with teams from Regina, Moose Jaw, Estevan, Weyburn and Yorkton. Extensive travel during the week will be considered when schedule is being made.

Cost estimates: ~\$200-250 for Saskatoon zone players for zone registration which will be transferred to the teams. Individual teams will have ~\$800 team fees depending on # of tournaments attending and other fundraising, etc. Travel, hotels and meals, etc. will be on top of that. Players may have to supply bats depending on team policies.
