You will be required to maintain the facility and grounds to a standard acceptable to host Provincial, Western Canadian or National events. Duties will include but are not limited to Appendix A which is attached.

Successful bidder will be responsible for all necessary insurances (\$2,000,000 Liability). You will supply all tools, field groomer and necessary equipment to maintain the facility at acceptable standards to the Saskatoon Baseball Council Inc. and their representatives.

Cairns Field operates on a daily/nightly schedule beginning in early May and ending in mid to late August. The user groups consist of the Saskatoon Senior Baseball League, Saskatoon Midget League and the Saskatoon Yellow Jackets. Field maintenance will start in mid April and end around late September. Games start at 6:30 pm and 9:00 pm on weekdays and vary on weekends.

Typically this facility hosts up to three (3) tournaments per year. Tournaments may start at noon on Friday and run through Sunday evening.

The successful bidder will have past experience maintaining a baseball complex and have basic knowledge of horticultural practices. They should have or able to obtain applicable Pest Applicators License (Landscape).

- Unlock/lock press box and building entrance doors
- Turn on/off lights
- Turn on/off scoreboard
- Arm/disarm alarm system

- Cut grass
- Attend to batting tunnels
- Paint/clean bases and home plate
- Empty garbage cans
- Clean Press Box

As Needed Jobs

- Paint foul lines
- Tarp mound & home plate
- Fertilize grass
- Spray & hoe weeds
- Weed warning track
- Rake leaves
- Combo plane infield
- Clean backroom
- Install/remove signs on outfield fence
- Installation of the batting cage netting at the beginning of the year and the tear down of same at the conclusion of the year.
- Replace bulbs in Scoreboard
